POWER WIRES – If a ball strikes a power wire, the player **MUST** replay the stroke. (Exception: Ball striking power wires to the right of insulators on 14 tower.)

TOWERS – Towers are immovable obstructions; Rule 24-2. A Ball hitting a tower is a “Rub of the Green”; Rule 19-1.

BALL DROPS – A ball in a water hazard on holes 1 and 15, as an additional option, may be dropped in the designated “Ball Drop” provided the ball drop is not nearer the hole than where the ball last crossed the margin of hazard.

OUT OF BOUNDS – Defined by Miner Road, Camino Sobrante, Bien Venida, Camino Pablo and the inside edge, at ground level, of fence posts and, where used, white stakes.

EMBEDDED BALL – Through the green, a ball embedded in its own pitch mark, may be lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to the spot where the ball lay but not nearer the hole.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS NEAR THE PUTTING GREEN – If a ball lies through the green and an immovable obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green, and within two club-lengths of the ball, intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Appendix 1-4A.

ACCIDENTAL MOVEMENT OF A BALL ON A PUTTING GREEN – Rules 18-2, 18-3 and 20-1 are modified as follows: When a player's ball lies on the putting green, there is no penalty if the ball or ball-marker is accidentally moved by the player, his partner, his opponent, or any of their caddies or equipment. The moved ball or ball-marker must be replaced as provided in Rules 18-2, 18-3 and 20-1. This Local Rule applies only when the player's ball or ball-marker lies on the putting green and any movement is accidental. Note: If it is determined that a player's ball on the putting green was moved as a result of wind, water, or some other natural cause such as the effects of gravity, the ball must be played as it lies from its new location. A ball-marker moved in such circumstances is replaced.

MINER ROAD – Except for the tee shot on hole 6, a ball hit across Miner Road that comes to rest beyond the road is out of bounds, even though it may lie on another part of the course.

SLOW PLAY – Any group with an open hole ahead must invite following group to play through. All 18 hole rounds are requested to be played in 4 hours or less.
